

**Disciplinary Reports:** On 7/15/04, the inmate received a DR for Possession of Contraband. According to the Statement of Facts, he had food items in his possession. He was found guilty and sentenced to extra duty only. He did not serve any confinement or lose any gain-time. On 4/6/03, I noted one *Corrective Consultation* for Disobeying Orders.

**Program Participation:** As of 2/6/07, Inmate Berry is only enrolled in Faith & Character at Wakulla CI. He has completed the following programs since his last interview:

- 9/03, Basic Computer Skill and Employability (Level I).
- 10/03, Certificate of Appreciation for contributions as facilitator for the Vocational Computer Technology course.
- 10/03, Basic Computer Electronics (Level II).
- 11/03, *Sex Offender Treatment Group*, active participation in 20 of 20 sessions.
- 7/04, Appreciation Award, for continued help beyond the call of duty for the Polk Literary Club.
- 5/05, Appreciation Award, for continued help beyond the call of duty for the Polk Literary Club.
- 12/05, Appreciation Award for continued help beyond the call of duty for the Polk Literary Club.
- 7/07, Computer Literacy Program, basic computer skills to operate Microsoft and Windows XP.

Additionally, Inmate Berry advised he is on the waiting list for a credit card class and Bridge.

**Transfers:** Since his last interview on 10/29/02, this inmate was transferred to different facilities for medical and educational needs. On 2/6/07, he was received at Wakulla CI for Faith & Character.

**Custody changes:** Inmate Berry continues to remain in close custody. He has been at this level since 7/7/90. Currently, his TRD is 10/26/2096.

**Security/Work Ratings:** Inmate Berry is currently assigned to the Inside Grounds. According to his institutional file, his ratings have all been outstanding since his last interview.

**Work release:** Inmate Berry does not qualify for work release due to his current custody status and his TRD.


**Attitude/Demeanor:** Inmate Berry displayed a polite and cooperative attitude during the interview. His demeanor appeared subdued.

**Inmate Comments:** Inmate Berry stated that he was guilty of the crimes and recognizes the consequences of his actions more and more, especially when he sees his children. He further indicated that he wants the Commission to know he is not a danger to the public anymore, and he takes full responsibility for his crimes. During the interview, he stated, "I know that if the Commission paroles me, and I violate, I will never see the streets again. I am willing to pay for any sex offender treatment they feel is necessary."

**Recommendation:** I am recommending an 18 month reduction in his PPRD which would set it at 7/6/2030. I further recommend he be re-interviewed in 36 months. This recommendation is based on his institutional conduct, program participation, notably the sex offender treatment, and his outstanding ratings.
